EVENT DETAILS

Venue

The event will take place at the **African Union Headquarters in Addis Abeba, Ethiopia.**

Transport

The organizers will provide transportation between the Radisson Blu Hotel (the main hotel for Interregional Dialogue participants) and the event venue.

Participants staying at other hotels are kindly requested to arrive at the Radisson Blu Hotel on time, as all transportation to the venue will depart from there.

Registration

In addition to registering for the event, participants may also be required to register on the African Union website to obtain a passcode for access to the African Union premises. Further information will be provided in due course. **Badges will be distributed at the registration desk at the Radisson Blu Hotel.**

ACCOMMODATION & MEALS

Participants are responsible for covering the costs of their airfare, accommodation, and airport-hotel-airport transfers. The organizers will provide lunches for accredited participants during the days of the event.

The suggested hotels below could provide complimentary airport shuttle service in accordance with your flight arrival and departure times in Addis Abeba (Bole international airport – Hotel - Bole international airport) if previously arranged directly with the hotels.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS TO ETHIOPIA

Visa requirements to enter Ethiopia

All participants, except citizens of Kenya and Djibouti, are **required to obtain a visa to enter Ethiopia**.

We strongly recommend applying for **a tourist e-Visa through the official Ethiopian Government** e-Visa portal before travelling: <https://www.evisa.gov.et/information/tourist>

The tourist e-Visa fee is **USD 62**, payable by card, and the standard processing time is approximately **three working days**. Participants are therefore advised to submit their application well in advance of their travel date.

Alternatively, **a tourist visa on arrival is available at Addis Ababa Bole International Airport**. The visa fee is payable upon arrival in cash (50 USD), and travellers should ensure they have the required amount available.

Vaccinations

A **yellow fever vaccination is mandatory**. The international certificate of vaccination against yellow fever becomes valid 10 days after vaccination. See <https://ephi.gov.et/travel-notice/> for more information.

EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICE

It will be the responsibility of each participant to contract a general travel assistance insurance to cover eventual expenses due to health problems during the days spent in Ethiopia, since the event's organization will not be responsible for this type of unforeseen events.

GENERAL INFORMATION ABOUT ADDIS ABABA

Addis Ababa is the capital city of the Federal Democratic Republic of Ethiopia.

Ethiopia is located in the eastern part of Africa, commonly known as the Horn of Africa, and covers a total area of approximately 1.14 million square kilometers.

Security

The overall security situation in Addis Ababa is stable. However, like in any other major city, participants are recommended to stay alert for their security during their stay in the city.

Currency

The official currency is the **Ethiopian Birr**. There are bills of 5, 10, 50, 100, 200 birr, and coins of 5, 10, 25 and 50 cents and 1 birr.

Major credit cards are widely accepted in shopping malls, restaurants, and ATMs. Only local currency can be withdrawn from ATMs.

Weather

From its lowest point, around Bole International Airport, at 2,326 meters (7,631 ft) above sea level in the southern periphery, Addis Ababa rises to over 3,000 meters (9,800 ft) in the Entoto Mountains to the north.

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The temperatures in Addis Abeba in December are generally mild and pleasant, with temperatures ranging between 10°C and 24°C (Low/High). December falls within the dry season, with warm, sunny days and little rainfall.

Voltage

For Ethiopia there are two associated plug types, types C and F. Plug type C is the plug which has two round pins and plug type F is the plug which has two round pins with two earthclips on the side. Ethiopia operates on a 220V supply voltage and 50Hz.

Local time

The time zone in Ethiopia is East Africa Time (EAT) (UTC+03:00).

Trade, hours and others

Banks and exchange offices: Monday to Friday, between 09:00 am and 4:00pm, Saturdays between 09:00 AM and 12:00 PM

Commercial offices: generally, from 9 am to 12 pm and from 2 pm to 7 pm.

Stores and businesses: Monday to Friday, 9 am to 9 pm. Saturdays, from 9 am to 7 pm. Coffee shops: they are usually open.

Restaurants: lunch is served from 12:30 pm and dinner from 8:30 pm onwards. Many of them offer fast food at all hours.

It is customary to leave 10% of the service charge in coffee shops and restaurants and to tip door attendants, baggage handlers and show ushers.
